
Children eligible for treatment at a Public Dental Clinic?

WHO ARE ELIGIBLE
FOR CHILD DENTAL
BENEFITS SCHEME

AGE 0-17 REFUGEES & ASYLUM SEEKERS

Children aged 13-17 who do not have a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, may not be eligible for dental treatment at a Public Dental Clinic. The parent/guardian can check their child's eligibility on the **Australian Department of Human Services website** by searching for 'child dental benefits schedule'.

An eligible patient wishes to seek dental treatment

On proof of eligibility, the parent/guardian will be asked questions and offered the next available appointment for treatment of pain.





Any eligible child who wants a check-up, clean or fillings can call **Dental Services Bendigo Health**.

They will be offered the next available appointment for a check-up and further treatment if needed will be planned.
