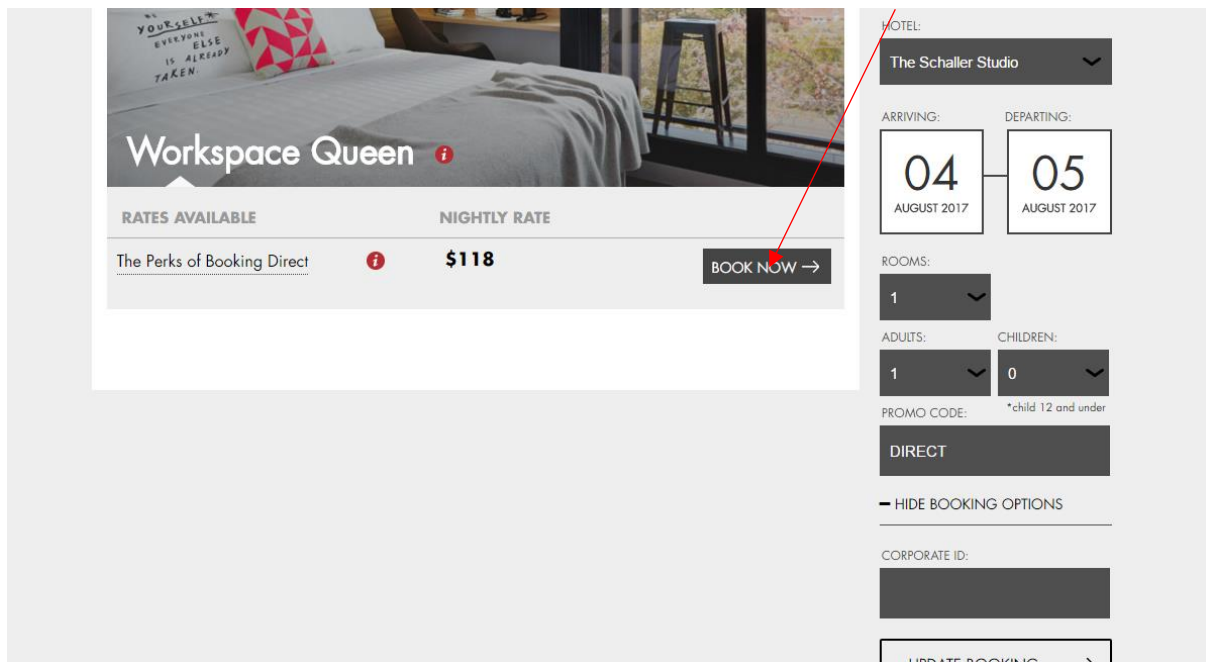

## **Conference FAQs**

### **What do I wear to the conference?**

Smart casual. We often suggest people wear layers. The conference is being held at Ulumbarra Theatre which has an excellent climate control system however to ensure your personal comfort, layers would be the way to go.

### **Do I need to bring food to the conference?**

Included in your ticket price is morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea.
