The Position

Registered Nurses in the Medical Imaging Unit are responsible for the provision of specialised nursing care for patients who present for diagnostic and interventional imaging procedures. Patients may present as inpatients or outpatients.

Nurses in the Medical Imaging Unit will also provide support to Medical Imaging Technologists in the provision of safe care and assist the team with smooth flow of patients through the department.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

- Provide general nursing care and observation of all patients whilst in the Medical Imaging department
- Assist the Radiologist with imaging procedures
- Ensure safe transportation of patients to and from Medical Imaging during operational hours
- To assist with the booking of procedures, utilising resources effectively and efficiently
- Maintain all emergency resuscitation equipment as per Bendigo Health policy
- Ensure equipment is maintained and ready for use
- Ensure consumable stock is maintained and available when required
- Effectively communicate relevant and important issues to the senior nurse or Medical Imaging Director
- Participate in the teaching and provision of relevant experience for all students of nursing allocated to the department
- Well-developed verbal, written, interpersonal, communication and computer literacy skills and knowledge.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

- 1. Sound clinical knowledge, skills and experience in acute nursing practice
- 2. Experience in minor procedure patient preparation and recovery
- 3. Ability to pass the Bendigo Health MRI safety questionnaire
- 4. A personal approach which is positive, enthusiastic, friendly and helpful
- 5. Ability to work as part of a team, as well as to work independently
- 6. Degree or equivalent in Nursing with current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency
- 7. Proven Radiology or Medical Practice experience
- 8. IV Cannulation competency
- 9. Ability to liaise and consult with relevant family members, team members and a broad range of health professionals and community agencies.

Desirable

10. Well-developed verbal, written, interpersonal, communication and computer literacy skills and knowledge
