The Position

The registered nurse is responsible for the safe and efficient delivery of nursing care to patients and families within a multidisciplinary framework. They must ensure that the wellbeing of the patient and family is the focus without prejudice. This includes assessment, planning and implementing care in consultation with the team leader/shift manager.

The registered nurse provides assistance to colleagues on a daily basis and more broadly on the vision and values of the Children's Ward.

As a registered nurse the applicant is expected to practise in a courteous manner independently and interdependently, assuming accountability for his/her own actions and the delegation of care to other nurses.

Professional accurate and thorough documentation is expected with a commitment to the ISBAR handover process as a basis. Ensure communication is clear and concise.

Maintaining open communication with all levels of staff is essential to this position

The Children's Ward promotes a supportive learning environment for all levels of nursing staff and students. The registered nurses are provided with learning opportunities to ensure the high standard of nursing care is maintained.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

- Function in accordance with legislation, conducting practice within a professional and ethical framework to deliver care that protects the rights of individuals and groups.
- To assist in the planning, delivery and evaluation of a high standard of nursing care in consultation with the health care team, patient and carers.
- To maintain and develop professional nursing standards and practice ensuring that annual competencies are met and continual learning needs are identified.
- To provide effective communication so as to include the patient, carers and the multi-disciplinary team in the immediate and ongoing health care
- To assess the need for and provide health education for patients and their carers.
- To refer relevant and important issues to the Senior Nurse or other health care team members.
- To provide leadership and direction and act as a positive role model, providing mentorship/preceptorship to less experienced nurses, including graduate nurses and under-graduate nursing students
- To work in your assigned unit or within your stream as the need arises and in accordance with your clinical competencies.

- Accept accountability for own actions and seek guidance from senior nursing staff when limited by own level of expertise.
- Practice within policy and procedural guidelines, including comply with health service policy regarding uniform, punctuality, annual Leave and ADO liability.
- To be responsible for the checking of clinical equipment ensuring its safe operation and cleanliness prior to use.
- Ensure all patients, clients, visitors and staff are treated with respect, dignity and courtesy in an environment that is free from harassment and discrimination.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

1. Registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (Australian Health Professionals Regulation Agency) as a Registered Nurse
2. Ability to work highly effectively in a multi-disciplinary, multi-functional environment
3. Demonstrated ability to operate with a high degree of flexibility within an environment with demanding workloads and time constraints

Desirable

4. Demonstrated clinical knowledge and skills relevant to the Unit speciality.
5. Knowledge of National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards
6. Demonstrated commitment to ongoing professional development.
7. Ability to work as part of an inter-disciplinary team as well as independently, with an ability to prioritise, set goals & objectives.
8. Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively with patients, visitors and staff at all levels within the organisation
9. A willingness and ability to learn
10. Demonstrates Bendigo Health's values of caring, passionate and trustworthy
