The Position

The BreastScreen Medical Imaging Technologist or Mammographic Technologist will perform high quality mammography and associated duties in accordance with standard radiographic practice and department policies and procedure. Mammography will include screening mammography, tomography and mammographic procedures as required.

The employee will work as part of a multidisciplinary team, performing examinations to a consistently high standard using a patient focused approach.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

- Operate within the legal boundaries and MRPB Code of Conduct and Professional Capabilities Standards, and ASMIRT Scope of Practice.
- Demonstrate a raised level of technical ability and skills in the production of the highest quality images that are reasonably achievable given the patient condition and in accordance with the ALARA principles.
- Ensure all examinations are performed efficiently with timing governed by clinical and patient need.
- Ensure all examinations are presented for reporting with minimum delay and with accurate recording of associated details.
- Act as a mentor or preceptor to less experienced mammographers, including interns and students.
- Recognise and report adverse events.
- Support nursing and medical staff in mammographic guided procedures.
- Collaborate with all multidisciplinary team members for the desired outcomes for patients.
- Conduct yourself in a manner that will not endanger yourself or others.
- Contribute to safety awareness and promotion by contributing feedback, ideas and suggestions.
- Report all radiation incidents immediately to the Radiation Safety Officer or Director of Medical Imaging.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

1. Demonstrated high level experience in mammography.
2. Current Victorian Radiation Use Licence.
3. Current AHPRA registration – Medical Radiation Practitioner, or Certificate of Graduate Diploma in Mammography.

4. Hold or be eligible to hold a Certificate of Mammographic Practice, or be willing to complete training to achieve this.
5. A positive, polite and professional approach when dealing with clients and colleagues.
6. Ability to work both as part of a team, and independently.

Desirable

7. Experience in the BreastScreen Australia program.
