## The Position

The Day Surgery nurse is a part of the Interventional Suite team that provides pre and postoperative care for patients in the following areas: Day of Surgery Admissions (DOSAs), Stage 2 and Stage 3 recovery and minor procedure operating theatres. The minor procedure theatres undertake gastrointestinal procedures (Gastroscopy, Colonoscopy, ERCP), Urology procedures (Cystoscopies) and Respiratory procedures (Bronchoscopy), and some minor surgical procedures.

## Responsibilities and Accountabilities

### Key Responsibilities

- A Registered Nurse Division 1 is required for this position; including advanced patient assessment skills and demonstrated medication administration competency.
- This selected staff member must be flexible and adaptable, with a requirement to train in all areas of Day Surgery including but not limited to; medical infusions administration, recovery room nursing pre & post-operative care areas, endoscopy suite, endoscopy reprocessing, scrubbing and scouting for minor surgical procedures.
- This position requires an understanding and demonstrated skills in gastroenterology/endoscopy procedures and the specific requirements for these procedures or the ability to learn these skills
- Requires a sound understanding of the methods for cleaning and processing of flexible endoscopes and their accessories.
- This position requires a commitment to ongoing professional development including the knowledge of current issues and trends
- This position requires excellent organisational skills and an ability to work well under pressure
- Contribution to quality projects and hospital accreditation is required

Employees are required to carry out lawful directions outlined above or delegated to them. The work to be performed is set out in this position description and, where relevant, any professional standards and codes of conduct and ethics issued by the relevant professional association.

## Key Selection Criteria

### Essential

1. Registration with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as a Registered Nurse without conditions
2. Advanced patient assessment skills and medication administration demonstrated competency
3. Demonstrated excellent interpersonal skills, with a strong team ethos and ability to work within a multidisciplinary health care team
4. Demonstrates excellent written and verbal communication skills, with experience in the use of electronic medical records and ability to learn new systems and processes.

5. Demonstrated evidence of ongoing professional development including the knowledge of current issues and trends of endoscopy and recovery

## Desirable

6. Previous experience in Day Surgery, Endoscopy or Perioperative areas
7. Relevant Post Graduate Qualification in Perioperative area or in an health related field
8. Knowledge and understanding of National Safety and Quality Health Service (NSQHS) Standards
9. Knowledge and understanding of GENCA guidelines and ACORN Standards
