## The Position

The Registered Nurse Ward 6A is responsible for the safe, timely and flexible delivery of nursing care to patients and families admitted to the unit. This encompasses assessing, planning and implementing patient care in consultation with the multidisciplinary team, while striving to improve patient access to care through understanding current trends in nursing and unit specific Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) . The successful candidate will be part of a dynamic team responsible for assessing and treating a wide cohort of patients with acute illness.

## Assessment and Treatment Unit (ATU)

The Assessment and Treatment Unit is a 15 bed unit that provides acute care for cardiac and med/surg inpatients requiring treatment for up to 72hours with a planned disposition to home. The Home Unit is Cardiology. The ATU team admits patients from the Emergency Department, Cardiac Catheter Laboratory, Interventional Suite, stepdown CCU, Short Stay Observational unit and the team works collaboratively with multidisciplinary colleagues to provide excellent care. A complex care room supports higher acuity patients with experienced nurses providing optimised nursing care at a 1:3 ratio 24/7.

## Short Stay Observation Unit

The Short Stay Observation Unit is a 16 bed fast paced, flexible unit that liaises directly with the Emergency Department to provide safe, timely access to care for Emergency patients requiring up to 24 hours admission. The SSOU has a dedicated ED Consultant and SSOU ANUM to oversee the high demand and optimise patient access to care.

## Responsibilities and Accountabilities

The Registered Nurse Ward 6A provides direct patient care and communicates effectively with the Nursing, Medical and Allied Health teams, patients and families so our patients receive excellent care.

## Key Responsibilities

- Practise quality, safe, patient centred direct clinical care within scope of practice, in line with the Australian Nursing Council (ANC) national competency standards, the Code of Ethics and the Code of Professional Conduct for nurses in Australia
- Plan, deliver and evaluate a high standard of clinical nursing care in consultation with the health care team.
- Assess and provide health education needs for patients and carers.
- Document all patient care within the electronic patient record (ePR) aligned with Bendigo Health policies and practices.
- Act as a positive role model providing mentorship and preceptorship to less experienced nurses, including nursing undergraduates on clinical placement.
- Demonstrate a sound understanding of directorate key performance indicators.
- Ensure safe operation and cleanliness of clinical equipment.

- Participate in the maintenance of relevant policies and procedures to ensure best practice.
- Participate in and contribute to team/departmental and organisational meetings.
- Participate in service development as required.
- Ensure compliance with Bendigo Health risk management policy and guidelines.
- Fairly and equitably work a rotating 7 day a week roster covering days evening and night shifts.

## Key Selection Criteria

5. Ability to work as part of a team, as well as to work independently
