The Position

Registered Nurses are an important member of the health care team at Bendigo Health.

This position is responsible for working collaboratively with team members to provide high quality care to patients/ clients and residents. The incumbent must operate within their scope of practice for the setting and specialty, and deliver care in accordance with best practice standards. They will also display a personal approach which is positive, respectful, collaborative and helpful.

As a nurse with HITH you will be expected to practice autonomously. There is an expectation you will consult, liaise, advise and co-ordinate with other services, internally and externally of Bendigo Health to enable coordinated and appropriate client care following discharge. In addition to providing direct care you will also empower clients and/or their carers, to develop goals and be actively involved in their care

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

This position is accountable/responsible for the following:

Direct clinical care:

- Provision and management of a caseload including complex care
- Provision of timely and comprehensive assessments of eligible clients and, with client involvement develop a supportive care plan that facilitates client empowerment and commitment to active participation in their healthcare
- Proven ability to work autonomously with minimal supervision
- Proven ability to manage a complex assessment and subsequent care planning
- Offer support, information and health education that is culturally relevant to clients and relatives/carers
- Respond to clinical changes in the client's condition and initiate consultation with relevant medical, nursing and allied health professionals as required
- Record relevant information in client files, and prepare necessary reports and documentation in accordance with the quality standards and organisational policies and protocols
- Work co-operatively as part of a multidisciplinary team
- Ensure clients are linked up with ongoing long-term supports in the community as required

Organisational Responsibilities:

- Participate in service development and quality improvement as required
- Participate in staff development and training as required

- Participate in team/departmental meetings and other organisational meetings as required
- Maintain accurate records, statistics and reports as needed
- Must be aligned to Bendigo Health values in all aspects of the role

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

1. Current Division 1 Registration with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA)
2. A current Victorian driver's licence is required for this position
3. Minimum of 3 years' post registration experience in nursing, in a clinical environment preferably with recent experience in a community setting
4. Demonstrated clinical knowledge, skills and or experience relevant to HITH services these include but are not limited to: IV cannulation, PICC and Porta Cath care management and maintenance, infusion Pump set up and VAC dressing application and management.
5. Demonstrated ability to be self-motivated, with high level skills in problem solving and time management skills to manage a caseload and meet deadlines, maintain schedules, set goals/objectives, as required
6. A demonstrated commitment and understanding of holistic, evidence-based care
7. A strong knowledge of the services available to support clients in their home and how to refer to such services
8. Act as a patient advocate to ensure consumer participation in all care/services planning
9. Highly developed verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills including computer literacy
