The Position

The primary focus of the role is to provide on-site services support, mainly all cleaning and washing services, for the EPC facilities inclusive of clinical and corporate services.

The scope of the role includes cleaning, linen supply, laundry duties, food handling and room setups with the aim to:

- ensure high quality cleaning support services to clients and staff;
- support the smooth operation of EPC services through high quality customer service; foster and support a home like environment;
- practise compliant hygiene and infection control measures; and report any risks that would impact on the delivery of cleaning or catering services.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

Cleaning

- Responsible for ensuring cleaning service duties are undertaken and completed in accordance with Bendigo Health policies, procedures and standards and the Cleaning Standards for Victorian Health Facilities 2011.
- Undertake tasks on domestic checklist/s in order to maintain a safe and clean environment for all clients and staff.
- Provide deep clean services as and when directed by Management.

Food Services

- Undertake safe food service duties in accordance with Bendigo Health Food Safety policy and procedures and in accordance with Food Standards Australia.
- Responsible for the control and monitoring of food temperatures and food expiry dates.
- Responsible for stock-take and re-ordering of stock as required.
- Demonstrated understanding and awareness to patient allergies and dietary requirements.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

- 1. Current Food Handlers Certificate.
- 2. Full understanding of the Australian Food Safety Standards.
- 3. Knowledge of Australian Cleaning Standards inclusive of infection control procedures.
- 4. Excellent cleaning skills with demonstrated experience, inclusive of a high level of attention to detail.
- 5. Demonstrated experience in serving of food and cleaning techniques, including correct manual handling techniques and safe use and storage of cleaning agents and chemicals.
- 6. Proven skills in working in an environmental services team.
- 7. Clear communication, customer service and interpersonal skills to ensure the ability to liaise effectively with clients and staff.

 EPC services close down for the period of Christmas/New Year and Easter and staff are encouraged to take annual leave at this time.
