The Position

The Dual Diagnosis Residential Rehabilitation Unit. The team is part of Bendigo Health's Mental Health and Wellbeing Service. The Dual Diagnosis Unit (DDU) is an 8 bed specialised rehabilitation program for patients experiencing co-occurring mental health and alcohol and/or other drug (AOD) problems.

The program provides a high level of support with simultaneous psychiatry and addiction expertise.

The expected length of stay is of 3 months, the team together with the resident will tailor a treatment plan that addresses the unique individual needs of the person

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the planning, delivery and evaluation of a high standard of nursing care in consultation with the health care team, patients and carers.
- To provide safe customer-focussed patients care in a multidisciplinary environment.
- Provide effective communication so as to include the patients' carers and the multi-disciplinary team
 in the immediate and ongoing health care.
- Assess the need for and provide health education for patients and their carers.
- Refer relevant and important issues to the Senior Nurse on duty or other health care team members.
- Provide leadership and direction and act as a positive role model, providing mentorship / preceptorship to less experienced nurses, including graduate nurses and under-graduate nursing students.
- Undertake (nursing) mental state, social state and physical assessments of patients, which will assist with recommendations for formulation of Individual treatment/recovery plans.
- Ensure the accurate documentation of client records during the shift.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

- 1. Current registration with AHPRA as a Registered Nurse
- 2. Experience working with co-occurring needs consumers, specific understanding of Addiction and the rehabilitation of this.

Desirable

- 3. Post graduate diploma, or working toward, in mental health or Alcohol and Drugs and/or related field
- 4. Knowledge and an understanding of the Mental Health and Wellbeing Act 2022 and other relevant legislation and their application to clinical practice
- 5. Proven ability to liaise and consult with relevant family members, team members and a broad range of health professionals and community agencies
- 6. Well-developed verbal, written, interpersonal, communication and computer literacy skills and knowledge
- 7. Demonstrated evidence of and a commitment to ongoing professional development.
