## The Position

The position is that of an Anaesthesia fellow at Bendigo Health, a large regional tertiary referral hospital, working in the Surgical Services Department.

The Department of Anaesthesia at Bendigo Health provides anaesthesia and related services to all interventional disciplines except Cardiac Surgery, Neurosurgery, and Transplant Surgery.

The Anaesthesia Team provides anaesthetic services for more than 12,000 operative procedures per year, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The service encompasses intra-operative anaesthesia, pre-anaesthetic assessment, acute pain management, anaesthesia outside the operating suite, and teaching and education throughout the hospital.

As Bendigo Health is an accredited training site, the position's responsibilities include teaching anaesthetic trainees, as well as other junior medical staff, medical students, and nursing staff.

## Responsibilities and Accountabilities

### Key Responsibilities

- Provide anaesthetic services, including appropriate pre- and post-operative care, within credentialed privileges to patients of BHCG at the relevant site and location as directed by the Director of Anaesthesia.
- Work towards providing best-practice care to all patients within the context of current professional knowledge and organisational resources.
- Promote and maintain a customer-focused ethos and a sense of pride and purpose in the service.
- Provide clinical leadership and supervision/teaching for junior medical staff as well as other clinical staff.
- Ensure appropriate interaction and service integration with other relevant services, especially the surgical services, Emergency Department and Critical Care Unit/Intensive Care Unit
- Communicate effectively within and external to Bendigo Health.
- Participate in team/departmental meetings and other organisational meetings as required.
- Participate in the departmental after-hours roster.
- Manage clinical and administrative portfolios on behalf of the Director of Anaesthetics/Clinical Unit Head.

### Key Selection Criteria

#### Essential

1. Full unconditional registration with AHPRA as a Medical Practitioner in Anaesthetics or other approved AHPRA registration types.
2. Working towards Fellowship of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (ANZCA) or Assessed by ANZCA via the SIMG pathway for obtaining FANZCA.

3. Demonstrated clinical ability commensurate with that expected of a specialist anaesthetist
4. Evidence of ongoing professional development to continually update personal medical knowledge and skills
5. A willingness and ability to learn

## Desirable

6. Demonstrated ability to develop and maintain effective service interactions required in the operation of a busy anaesthetic service
7. Good understanding of the Victorian Public Health system; in particular the clinical and quality requirements for anaesthetic service delivery
8. Ability to work as part of a multi-disciplinary team, as well as independently
9. Ability to interact and communicate with a diverse range of people at all levels
