Orthopaedic Surgery

The Orthopaedic unit situated on Ward 4B comprises 32 beds with 9 orthopaedic surgeons providing a wide range of services to both public and private patients. The unit provides both elective and trauma management and acts as a conduit to metropolitan hospitals where required. We receive many trauma patients from outlying facilities without an orthopaedic service. We have VMOs consulting at Swan Hill, Kerang, Cohuna, Castlemaine and Kyneton. We have dedicated physiotherapists and occupational therapists and work very closely together to ensure a smooth transition through our service. We strive to educate and support emergency department staff who vary in level of experience. We have operating sessions every day and outpatient/fracture clinics up to 4 days per week.
