- 12 month program with commencement date to be advised.
- ENGTNP participants are employed 4 days a week (0.8 EFT)
- Participants will have comprehensive orientation days designed to support work readiness
- Numerous paid study days are held over the course of the program
- 2 clinical rotations of 6 months each in either Adult Acute Unit, Older Person Unit, Extended Care Unit and Bendigo Adult Community Mental Health and Wellbeing Team are offered
- All participants will receive individual and group clinical supervision
- Preceptor allocated for each rotation
- Comprehensive, ongoing competency based skills assessments.
- Successful completion of the Graduate Program will give the Grad/Transition EN at least 0.6FTE ongoing employment at Bendigo Health
