1 September 2021 to 28 February 2022

Ward 4C: Rehabilitation / GEM Unit 32 beds

- The name of the mixed ward: Ward 4C
- The total number of occupied beds in the mixed ward: 32 beds (16 x Rehabilitation and 16 x GEM)
- The different ratios that would apply to each portion;
 - o Rehabilitation: AM shift 1:5 plus in charge, PM shift 1:5 plus in charge, ND shift 1:10
 - o **GEM:** AM shift 1:5 plus in charge, PM shift 1:6 plus in charge, ND shift 1:8
- The expected number of occupied beds in each portion of the ward during the following 6month period: 32 beds

Ward 5C: Rehabilitation / GEM Unit 32 beds

- The name of the mixed ward: Ward 5C
- The total number of occupied beds in the mixed ward: 32 beds (16 x Rehabilitation and 16 x GEM)
- The different ratios that would apply to each portion;
 - o Rehabilitation: AM shift 1:5 plus in charge, PM shift 1:5 plus in charge, ND shift 1:10
 - o **GEM:** AM shift 1:5 plus in charge, PM shift 1:6 plus in charge, ND shift 1:10
- The expected number of occupied beds in each portion of the ward during the following 6month period: 32 beds

Specialist Palliative Care and Evaluation Unit: Palliative Care / GEM / TCP 25 beds (intention to increase to 30 beds from 1/11/2021)

- The name of the mixed ward: Specialist Palliative Care and Evaluation Unit
- The total number of occupied beds in the mixed ward: 25 beds (10 x Palliative Care, 8 x GEM and 7 x TCP). From 1 November 2021 30 beds (10 x Palliative Care, 8 x GEM and 12 x TCP.
- The different ratios that would apply to each portion;
 - o **Palliative Care:** AM shift 1:4 plus in charge, PM shift 1:4 plus in charge, ND shift 1:6 plus in charge
 - o **GEM/TCP:** AM shift 1:5 plus in charge, PM shift 1:6 plus in charge, ND shift 1:10
- The expected number of occupied beds in each portion of the ward during the following 6month period: Palliative Care 9 beds, GEM 8 beds, TCP 9 beds.
