The Position

A Registered Undergraduate Student of Nursing (RUSON) or Registered Undergraduate Student of Midwifery (RUSOM) within Clinical Operations is a person who is currently enrolled at a university undertaking

undergraduate nursing or midwifery studies, is registered with AHPRA as a student nurse or midwife, and who, at commencement, has successfully completed not less than twelve (12) months of the Bachelor of Nursing or Bachelor of Midwifery degree.

The RUSON/RUSOM assists in the delivery of patient-centred, evidence-based care within a multidisciplinary team environment. Under the delegation and supervision of a registered nurse, the RUSON/RUSOM works collaboratively with other health care professionals to achieve the best possible outcomes for patients in their care.

The RUSON/RUSOM will be allocated to Clinical Operations and will work in accordance with specific ward duty lists as directed by the nurse in charge. The RUSON/RUSOM forms an integral part of the Clinical Operations team.

Units within Bendigo Health where a RUSON/RUSOM may be employed include:

- Psychiatric Older Persons Units
- Women's Ward (RUSOM only)
- Children's Ward

RUSONs/RUSOMs are required to work shifts of not less than four (4) hours for day or evening shifts, or ten (10) hours for night shifts, Monday through Sunday.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

- A RUSON/RUSOM is required to work under the supervision and delegation of a Registered Nurse (RN) at all times and within the parameters of this RUSON/RUSOM position description.
- A RUSON/RUSOM will complete performance appraisals and reviews in accordance with Bendigo Health policy.
- A RUSON/RUSOM must maintain their academic obligations in the Bachelor of Nursing or Bachelor of Midwifery and remain an active student throughout their fixed-term employment.
- A RUSON/RUSOM will work with one or more Registered Nurses to provide delegated activities in accordance with this position description.
- The RUSON/RUSOM will function in accordance with relevant legislation and the organisation's local policies and procedures, conducting practice within a professional and ethical framework to deliver delegated care.
- The RUSON/RUSOM will collaborate and consult with the Registered Nurse and other multidisciplinary team members to achieve desired health outcomes for patients.

- The RUSON/RUSOM will ensure all residents, families, clients, visitors, and staff are treated with respect, dignity, and courtesy in an environment free from harassment and discrimination.
- The RUSON/RUSOM accepts accountability and responsibility for practising safely within the scope of this RUSON/RUSOM position description.
- The RUSON/RUSOM works collaboratively with both Bendigo Health and the relevant university to ensure the requirements of both organisations are met.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

1. Current enrolment in a Bachelor of Nursing/Midwifery Program or equivalent (i.e. Master of Nursing).
2. Completed first year of Bachelor of Nursing/Midwifery Program or equivalent (i.e. Master of Nursing).
3. Demonstrated satisfactory academic progress in the Bachelor of Nursing/ Midwifery (credit or above for all subjects and competency in clinical placements preferred but not essential) and evidence of successful completion of all units of study from the second year of a Bachelors Program or the first year of study of a post graduate/master's program at a participating university.
4. Registration as a student nurse with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) with no conditions or undertakings.
5. Ability to work AM, PM and night shifts over a 7 day roster.
6. Effective organisational skills in respect to time management and delegation.
7. Well-developed written, verbal and electronic communication and interpersonal skills with the ability to convey information effectively to others.
8. A demonstrated commitment to high quality, safe and person centred care.
9. Ability and willingness to learn and operate in an environment of change with a personal approach which demonstrates values such as caring, passionate and trustworthy.
10. Proven ability to work effectively and cooperatively with a multi-disciplinary health care team whilst maintaining good relationships
