


Getting my COVID Vaccination at the kidzone at Bendigo hub



The vaccine is in a needle.




The vaccine needle puts medicine in my body to keep me from getting sick from Covid-19.


When I get to the Vaccination Hub there will be someone to meet me and my family.
They will take me straight through to the kids area.




The kids area has lots of things I can do.




I can play a game of hopscotch or play with bubbles or I can sit in a nice comfy chair and look at all the animal pictures that are on the wall.

I can choose to sit on a chair or on a bean bag or even stand up.




The nurse will ask the adult I'm with some questions about me. They will put the information into their computer so people will know I've had my vaccination.

When I am ready I will find a seat where I feel comfortable.

The nurse will give me the vaccine needle.
It will feel like a pinch or a prick.

The nurse will put a cotton ball and some tape on my arm.



After I have had my needle I will get a special show bag, some water and a lollipop.



I will have to wait for 15 minutes after my needle to make sure I feel okay.

I can sit or lie down and play with the things that are in my show bag.



After 15 minutes the nurse will check that I feel Ok.
Then I can go home.
